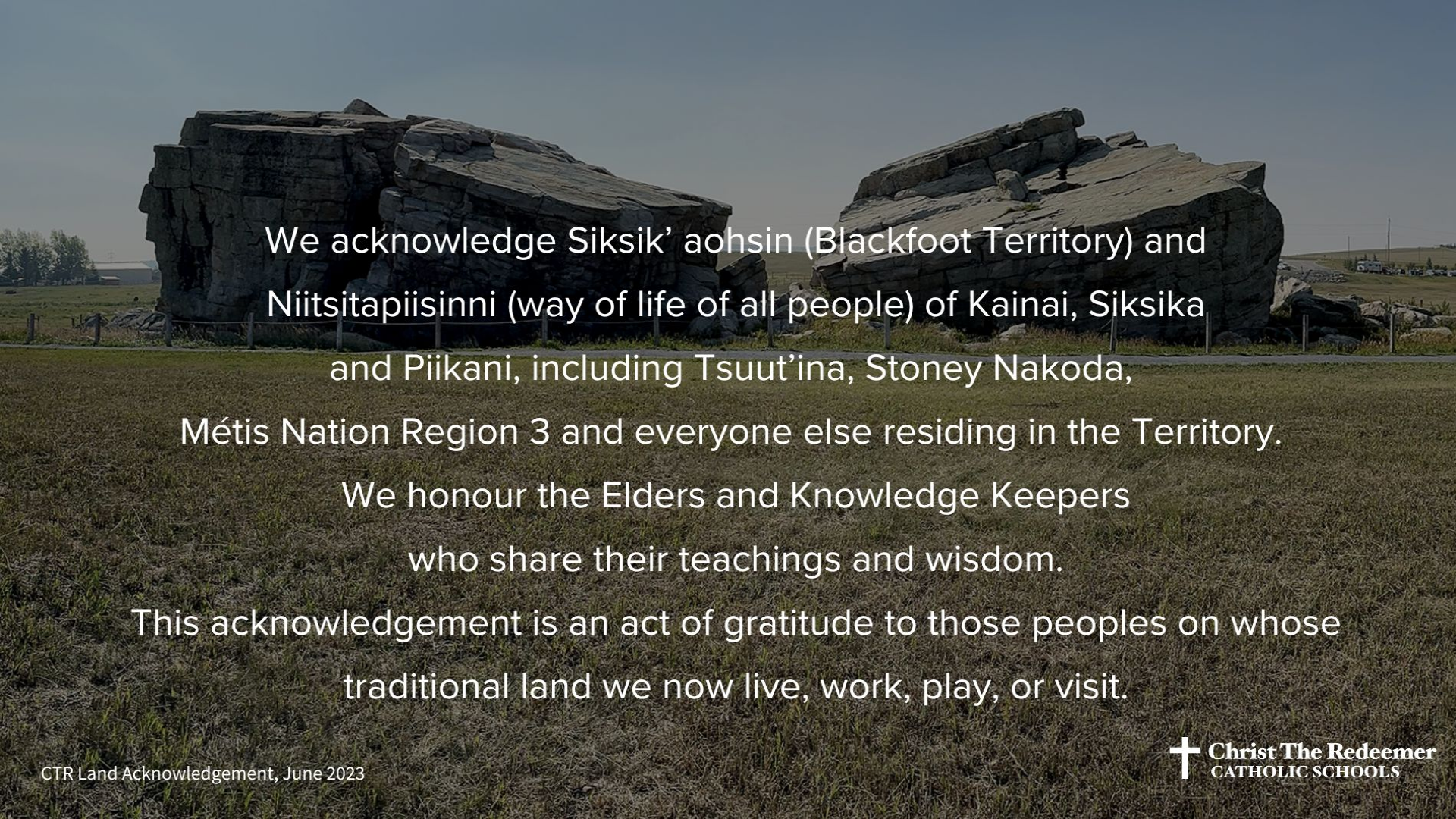

Our goal for this session is to involve our stakeholders on the project by providing an update and accepting feedback that may be implemented now and in the next phase of planning.

Building History

- Sacred Heart Academy formed in 2001 and Holy Cross Collegiate opened in 2004.
- Existing initial facility is 73 years old (1951) provided to CTR upon formation in 2001. Previously the building was used for public schools, who received a new school building and no longer required this space.
- Original facility renovations included additions in 1955, 1958, 1963, and 1972. CTR managed the addition of the HCC portion in 2001 and renovations to the facility in 2003, 2011, and 2020, and added modulares in 2007, 2008, and 2014.
- The utilization rates for our Strathmore schools are 64% and 70%. Although extremely successful and viable, this would not meet the threshold for a capital funding announcement from the provincial government.
- As such, the use of CTR's capital reserves to proceed with planning was approved by the Board of Trustees in 2023.
- The need for the return to a full sized gymnasium for SHA as well as an improved band room for HCC initiated the project.

Project Progression to Date

- LOLA Architecture awarded design contract in August 2023
- Lead team participating in weekly planning meetings
- Construction company Chandos awarded contract in January 2024
- The initial budget was authorized at \$1,815,709
- In January 2024 the budget was revised to account for inflation, and was approved at \$2,520,000
- The majority of the budget is allocated to the new band room and chapel spaces.
- Engagement with administration, division, school staff

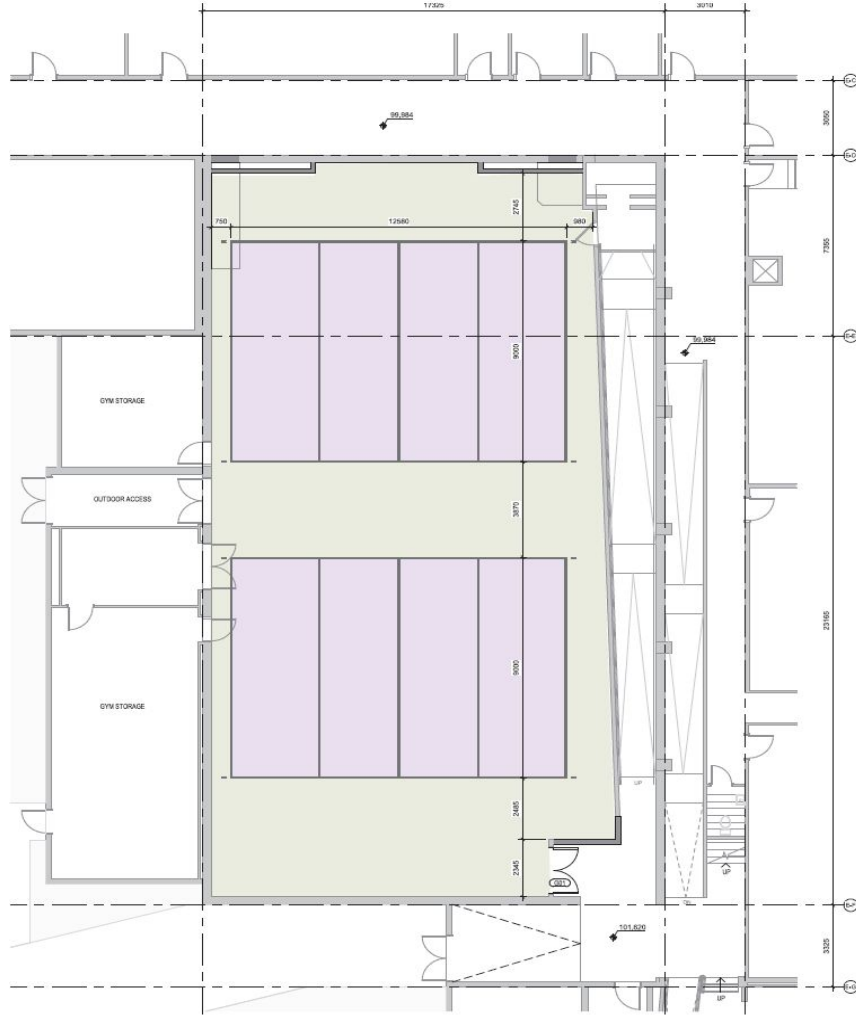


HCC Chapel

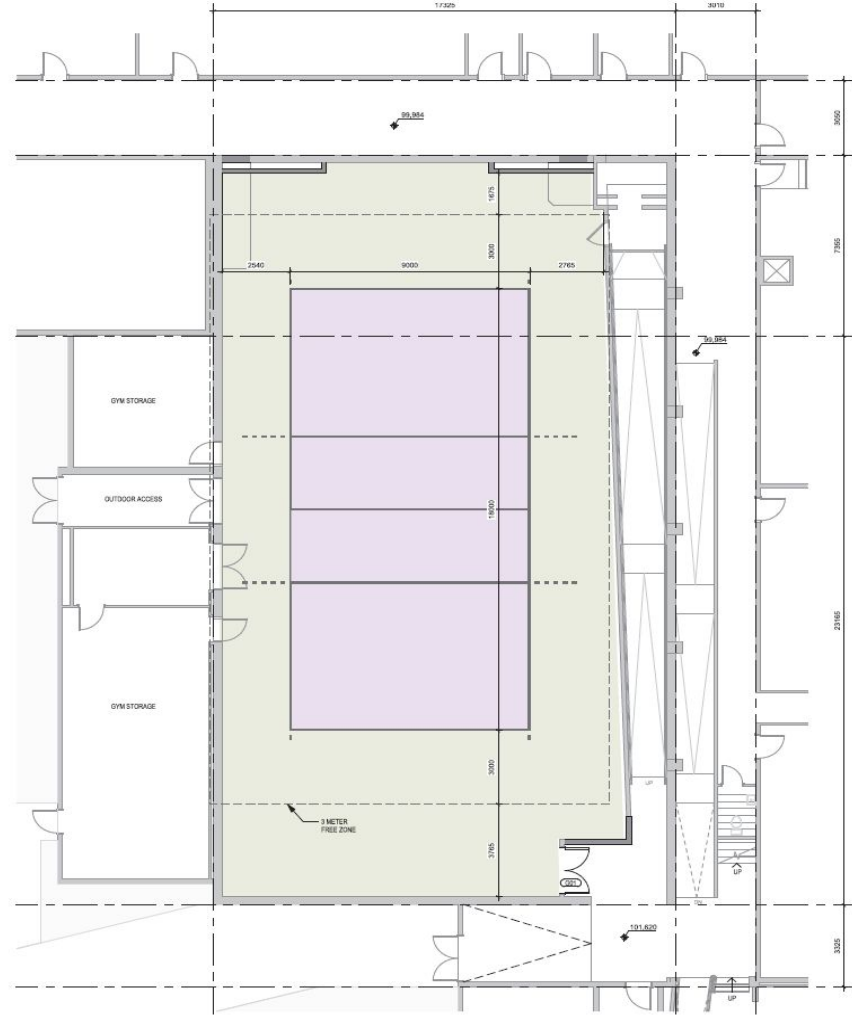




SHA Gymnasium

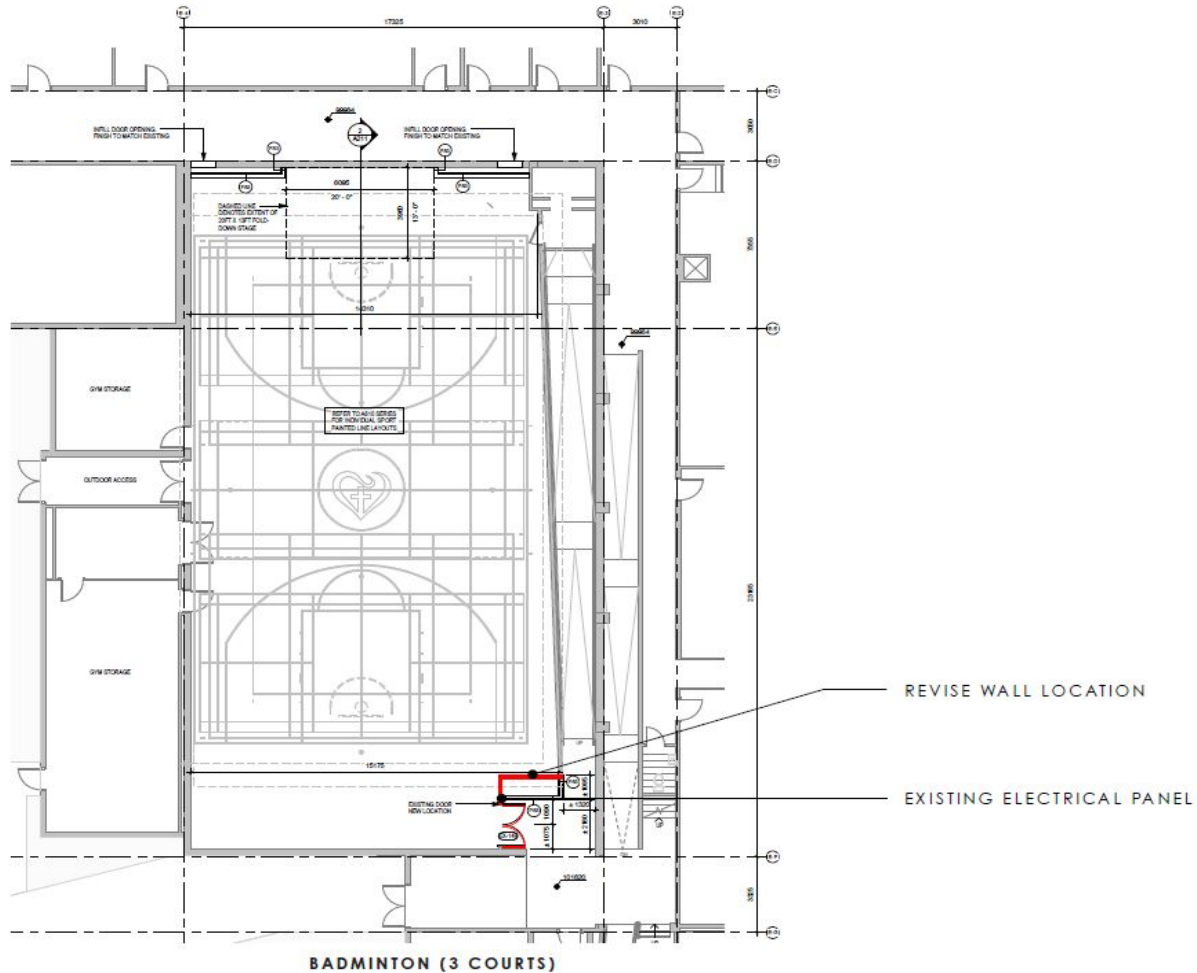


VOLLEYBALL (HALF COURT)
